

Special Instructions for Economics Submissions

Classification codes for Economics

Please provide up to at least 3 standard JEL codes. The available codes may be accessed at JEL (<https://www.aeaweb.org/jel/guide/jel.php>).

Figure Format

Please make sure that artwork files including tables, photographs, figures and/or graphs are in an acceptable format (TIFF (or JPEG), EPS (or PDF), or MS Office files) and with the correct resolution.

General points for illustrations or artworks,

- Make sure you use uniform lettering and sizing of your original artwork.
- Embed the used fonts if the application provides that option.
- Use the uniform fonts in your illustrations.
- Number the illustrations according to their sequence in the text.
- Provide captions to illustrations separately.
- Size the illustrations close to the desired dimensions of the published version.
- Keep the resolution to a minimum of 300 dpi for Grayscale illustrations and a minimum of 1000 dpi for colored illustrations.

Mathematical equations

- Equations should be typed on separate lines and numbered consecutively at the left margin.

Authors are requested to use the editable version for mathematical equations.

- Subscripts and superscripts must be easily distinguished from regular variables and from each other. Use only two levels of sub- and superscripts.
